In the first half of the 20th century, Paris was the undisputed centre of the art world. This book showcases 115 works from that period chosen for an exhibition at New York's Metropolitan Museum of Art. The 39-volume set, comprising the LNCS books 13661 until 13699, constitutes the refereed proceedings of the 17th European Conference on Computer Vision, ECCV 2022, held in Tel Aviv, Israel, during October 23-27, 2022. The 1645 papers

presented in these proceedings were carefully reviewed and selected from a total of 5804 submissions. The papers deal with topics such as computer vision; machine learning; deep neural networks; reinforcement learning; object recognition; image classification; image processing; object detection; semantic segmentation; human pose estimation; 3d reconstruction; stereo vision; computational photography; neural networks; image coding; image reconstruction; object recognition; motion estimation. In this book, Bernard Comment examines the wide variety of panoramas featuring both the old and the new worlds. Included among views of cities are Robert Baker's View of Edinburgh and depictions of Paris, Moscow and Lima. Rainer Strzolka (°1956, Berlin, Germany) is an artist who mainly works with photography. By emphasising aesthetics, Strzolka absorbs the tradition of remembrance art into daily practice. This personal follow-up and revival of a past tradition is important as an act of meditation. His collected, altered and own photos are being confronted as aesthetically resilient, thematically interrelated material for memory and projection. The possible seems true and the truth exists, but it has many faces, as Hanna Arendt cites from Franz Kafka. In a search for new methods to 'read the city', he wants to amplify the astonishment of the spectator by creating compositions or settings that generate tranquil poetic images that leave traces and balances on the edge of recognition and alienation. His works appear as dreamlike images in which fiction and reality meet, well-known tropes merge, meanings shift, past and present fuse. Time and memory always play a key role. By contesting the division between the realm of memory and the realm of experience, he focuses on the idea of 'public space' and more specifically on spaces where anyone can do anything at any given moment: the non-private space, the non-privately owned space, space that is economically uninteresting. His works demonstrate how life extends beyond its own subjective limits and often tells a story about the effects of global cultural interaction over the latter half of the twentieth century. It challenges the binaries we continually reconstruct between Self and Other, between our own 'cannibal' and 'civilized' selves. By demonstrating the omnipresent lingering of a 'corporate world', he seduces the viewer into a world of ongoing equilibrium and the interval that articulates the stream of daily events. Moments are depicted that only exist to punctuate the human

drama in order to clarify our existence and to find poetic meaning in everyday life. His works are often classified as part of the new romantic movement because of the desire for the local in the unfolding globalized world. However, this reference is not intentional, as this kind of art is part of the collective memory. By applying a poetic and often metaphorical language, he creates work through labour-intensive processes which can be seen explicitly as a personal exorcism ritual. They are inspired by a nineteenth-century tradition of works, in which an ideal of 'Fulfilled Absence' was seen as the pinnacle. His works are often about contact with architecture and basic living elements. Energy (heat, light, water), space and landscape are examined in less obvious ways and sometimes developed in absurd ways. Here there is an excerpt of his diaries. 1999 one photographer documented street scenes and areas of historic interest around Mt. Pleasant, Michigan using a panoramic Noblex camera featuring a lens in a rotating barrel. This work included the use of ladders, roofs, lifts and sometimes standing in the middle of roads. Before there were cell phones that could record panoramas, this film-based method was one way in which this was done. Later work graduated to digital cameras and a fisheye lens. This is a sampling of this work over the years. Gulf Panorama examines the history of panoramas as a visual form, as well as depictions of the Gulf South as panoramic space. Through a review of painting, photography, representational technologies, and other media, Gulf Panorama proposes that the panorama is a historical form with urgent contemporary resonance, particularly in regard to the precarious geographies of the Gulf South. Gulf Panorama opens with an index that links my various research interests. These interests include Black Geographies, psychogeography, and literary approaches to landscape and Black interiority. This index functions not just as a record of the concerns of my practice, but also as an approach to documenting a genealogy of reference points. The index locates terms that are not only confined to the references within this paper. The index is followed by scholarly research and documentation of tactics and theories that have emerged over the course of my practice. Gulf Panorama serves as an entry point to a contextualization of my work with Gulf South (and Gulf of Guinea) landscapes as a subset of a larger series of concerns. My practice, through form and conceptual underpinnings, addresses the histories and evolution of the panorama. I take up the form of the panorama while situating my work within investigations of visibility, legibility, representation, and opacity. This book provides a contemporary overview of developing areas of copyright law in the Asian Pacific region. While noting the tendency towards harmonisation through free trade agreements, the book takes the perspective that there is a significant amount of potential for the nations of the Asian Pacific region to work together, find common ground and shift international bargaining power. In-depth analysis of Victor Burgin's video installation *Parzival* (2013) In commemoration of the destruction of the University Library of Leuven (Belgium) in August 1914, the projection work *Parzival*, created by Victor Burgin (°UK, 1941) in 2013, was installed within the rebuilt Library. The installation uniquely marked the 100th anniversary of the beginning of World War I, which left its profound traces on both the consciousness and physiognomy of the city of Leuven. Burgin's reflection on Richard Wagner's opera *Parsifal* (premiere 1882) combines the artist's computer modelled images (a bombed out street, a sunset meadow, a Venetian palazzo, ...) with citations from Roberto Rossellini's *Germany Year Zero* (1948) and references to works by Milan Kundera, W.G. Sebald and Philip K. Dick. This publication provides an in-depth analysis of *Parzival*, a work that is inspired by the period of seven months that Wagner spent in Venice (1858-1859). Burgin's *Parzival* raises questions about some of the most fundamental elements in Wagner's operatic work: the longing for a savior, the complex connection between violence and catharsis, and the presentiment that destruction awaits humanity in the future (*Götterdämmerung*). In an associative manner, *Parzival* brings together various artistic and political features to confront the romantic ideal of the ruin with the horrors that might result from such a myth. In addition, this book contains a reprint of Michel Foucault's essay "The Imagination of the Nineteenth Century" (1980).
